

Market integration: support schemes


- Feed-in tariff
- Premium
- Quota



Phase in market exposure:

- ❖ Competitive allocation mechanisms
- ❖ Mechanism to reflect degree of maturity of technology
- ❖ Competition among RES – technology development
- ❖ Minimise impact on production decision

- Initial progress towards meeting the 2020 RES has been good, but there is no room for complacency...






2030 targets: where we should go? - learning from the past




- *The 2030 framework will build on the 2050 Roadmaps*
- Concrete proposal by the start of 2014





GERMAN PV COST AND REMUNERATION




● Renewable energy policy post-2020: business as usual is not an option
